Foras na Gaeilge promotes reading and publishing primarily through An Gúm, Áis and Clár na Leabhar Gaeilge (the Irish language books scheme).

An Gúm provides publications and resources to support education through the medium of Irish and the use of Irish in general. Today An Gúm mainly deals with lexicography, textbook publishing and school resources and reading material for young people. Foras na Gaeilge has a particular legislative duty in regard to these matters.

Áisíneacht Dáiliúchán Leabhar (Áis) (the Books Distribution Agency) was established to distribute Irish language publications at home and abroad. Áis provides a distribution service for Irish language publishers and ensures a supply of Irish language books on the market.

Through Clár na Leabhar Gaeilge, Foras na Gaeilge provides support for Irish language publishers through the Publishing Scheme, and for Irish language writers mainly through the writers' schemes.

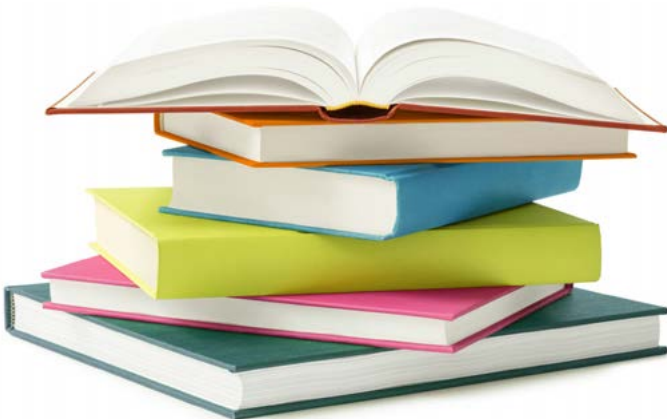


An Gúm have been publishing high quality materials for more than 90 years. Today, our main areas of work are:

of your journey?*



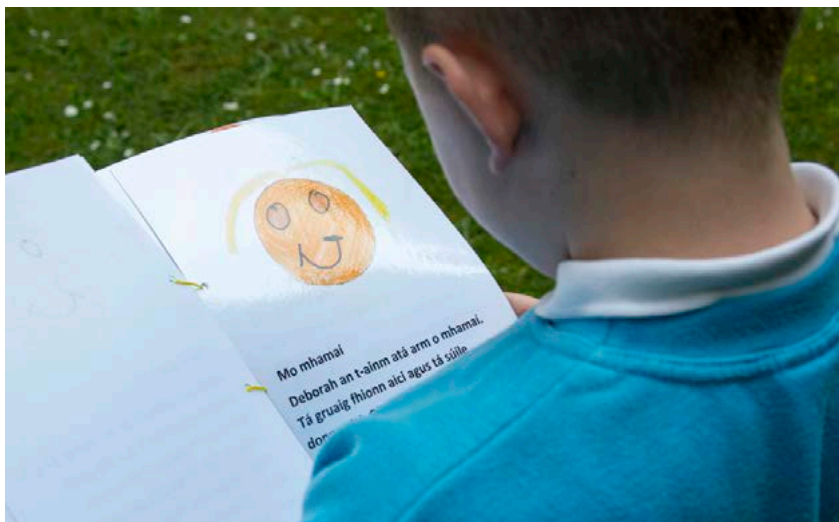
Clár na Leabhar Gaeilge
